Gold Star Survivor Card

Does not grant base access or benefits not already eligible for; in some instances, may be used as a valid form of Survivor identification. Reach out to your Navy Gold Star coordinator for more information.

Gold Star Parking Sign and Placard

Located throughout Navy installations. If you see one of these signs, please respect who they are reserved for; if you are a Gold Star family and would like a parking placard, please reach out to your Navy Gold Star coordinator.



Gold Star Lapel Button

Worn by Survivors of service members who died in an armed conflict or act of terrorism from WWI to the present.

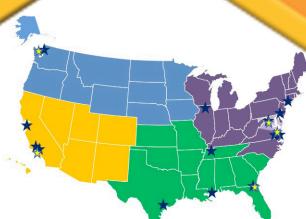
Next of Kin Lapel Button
